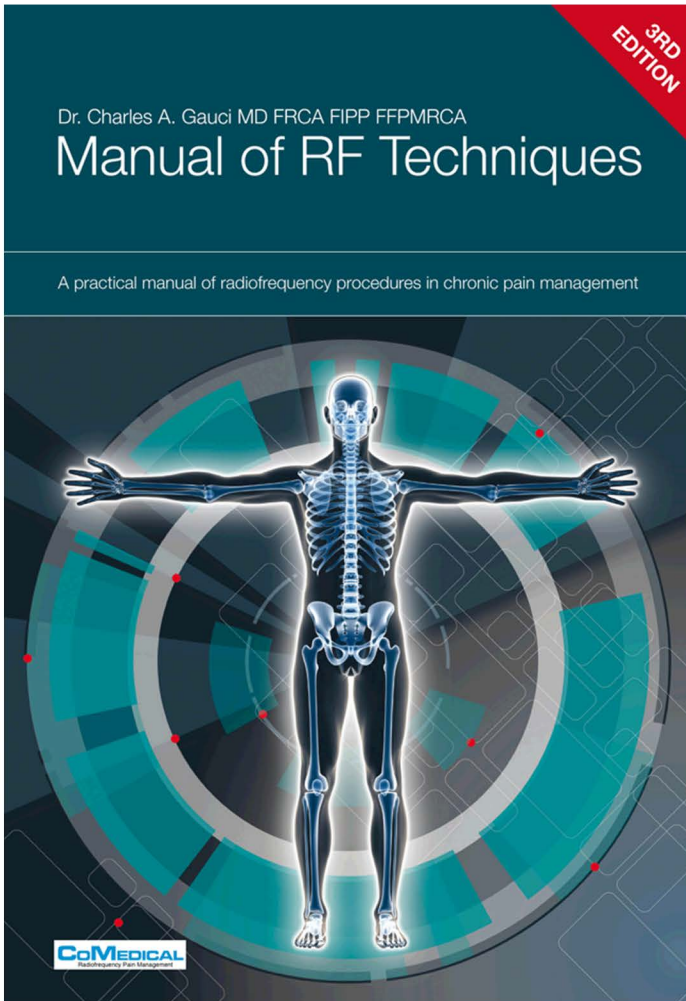

Dr. Charles A. Gauci has been actively involved in chronic pain management since 1979. He is Lead Consultant in pain management at Whipps Cross University Hospital, London and Honorary Consultant in pain management at Guy's & St. Thomas' Hospital, London, UK as well as Visiting Consultant in pain management to the Ministry of Health in Malta. He founded one of the first clinical fellowships in chronic pain management in the UK and is also Honorary Secretary of the World Institute of Pain (WIP), a Trustee of the WIP Foundation and an examiner for the FIPP Diploma.

Over the years, Dr. Gauci has acquired a considerable reputation as a teacher of radiofrequency techniques both in his fellowship programme as well as at cadaver workshops and meetings, worldwide. Many years ago, he noticed a demand for a simple and straightforward 'how to do it' radiofrequency handbook, concentrating on essentials and which could be taken into the operating theatre when carrying out procedures.

This demand led to the publication of the first edition of *'Manual of RF Techniques'* in 2004. The book was an international success and subsequently also published in Spanish and Korean editions. It rapidly sold out and a 2nd, Updated edition was produced in 2008; this was also an international success and having likewise sold out produced the demand for this, 3rd, further updated, edition.

This edition contains special guest chapters from several big names in the field of interventional pain management, viz. Professor Alex Cahana, Professor Eric Cosman and Dr. Eric Cosman jr., Professor Phillip Finch, Professor Miles Day and Dr. Olaf Rohof.

As in previous editions, this is an easy to follow instruction manual, which will be of great use to the novice as well as to the more experienced doctor. The text is reduced to a bare minimum and is accompanied by a series of clear illustrations to guide the interventional pain physician step-by-step through all the widely used radiofrequency procedures.

The format used in this book is the same as in previous editions, namely one of spring-bound laminated pages, which allow the reader to add his/her own notes with the supplied waterproof pen, thus enabling the manual to become a trusted friend in times of need.

This book is, as always, an invaluable tool for those who are interested in interventional pain management, especially if they intend to sit for the FIPP Diploma of the World Institute of Pain.
